

Course evaluation questionnaire for courses including laboratory practice

This questionnaire is filled in anonymously by students for internal use of the department's Internal Evaluation Committee. For each question you must choose a value from 1 to 5, with the value 1 corresponding to the lowest grade (Not at all/Unacceptable) and the value 5 corresponding to the highest grade (Very good/very much); for the final question (Remarks and comments) you may enter free text.
